OVERALL OBJECTIVE

Overcoming current contradictions associated with local water management in Mediterranean river basins through innovative institutional solutions, based on common understanding of six key axes: social, institutional, territorial, historical, agricultural, hydrological-hydraulic.

APPROACH

Build well documented case studies within 11 river basins in 6 different Mediterranean countries in mountain, plains and deltas.

ORGANISATION

A general coordination unit and a local team in the six mediterranean countries.
