Bidding will be conducted through the International Competitive Bidding (ICB) procedures specified in the World Bank's Guidelines: Procurement under IBRD Loans and IDA Credits, May 2004, revised in October 2006 and May 2010 and is open to all bidders from Eligible Source Countries as defined in the Guidelines.

- 5. Bids can be submitted either for one contract (Lot 1 or Lot 2 or Lot 3) or for all three contracts (Lot 1, Lot 2 and Lot 3). Separate bids shall be prepared and submitted for each lot. Evaluation for each lot will be conducted separately and the Contract will be awarded to the bidder who has the lowest evaluated responsive bid for this particular lot.
 - If the bidder with the lowest evaluated bids for all three contracts meets the combined criteria for Lots No 1, No 2 and No 3 specified in Items ITB 11.1 (g) and 11.1(h) (i) of the Bidding Data Sheet, the Bidder will be awarded three contracts. (b) The Bidder shall demonstrate that it has successfully performed at a minimum:

For Lot 1 - 1 (one) contract during the past three (3) year supply of Water meters and their spare parts wherein the number of meters supplied per contract was in excess of 5,000;

For Lot 2 - 1 (one) contract during the past three (3) year supply of Water meters boxes and covers wherein the number of Water meters boxes and covers supplied per contract was in excess of 5,000;

For Lot 3 - 1 (one) contract during the past three (3) year supply of Water meters test benches and their spare parts.

- (c) in the case of a bidder offering to supply goods under the Contract which the bidder does not manufacture or otherwise produce, the bidder has been duly authorized by the goods' manufacturer or producer to supply the goods in the Purchaser's country;
- (d) The goods shall be I.S.O. (or with equivalent quality management system certification) certified. A margin of preference for certain goods manufactured domestically "shall not" be applied. Additional details are provided in the Bidding Documents.
