- Topographic & bathymetric survey of the Gali reservoir and definition of the reservoir volume-depth relationship (surface area of the reservoir is approximately 7 km<sup>2</sup>),
- Survey (topographic & bathymetric) of cross-sections along the 23km channel from Vardnili HPP #1 to the outfall at the Black Sea coast (approximately 64 cross-sections are required, and the channel is typically approximately 60 m wide),
- Topographic & bathymetric survey in the vicinity of the Vardnili HPP Cascade discharge channel at the Black Sea coast (including survey of the Black Sea bed up to 15 m depth, with some locations up to 80 m depth),
- All of the above works (including reporting and provision of Digital Terrain Models) to be completed within 4 months from the Date of Commencement.

Tendering for contracts to be financed with the proceeds of a loan from the Bank is open to firms from any country.

To be qualified for the award of a contract, tenderers must satisfy the following minimum criteria:

- Tenderers shall be specialist survey companies having expertise in both topographic and bathymetric survey,
- Tenderers shall demonstrate relevant previous experience in similar survey projects over a period of at least 3 years.
